The use of these substances and these behaviors may be harmful and illegal Students who represent MTHS should refrain from being involved in any of the above actions A student shall be considered in violation of this code if he/she admits to violating the code, is reported by a schools staff member, their parent or guardian, or law enforcement official, or a court fine or conviction. A refusal to submit to a drug or alcohol test will be considered an admission of guilt. This applies on or off school grounds, in or out of season. These rules apply when student graduates from grade school until student graduates from high school. The following penalties will apply for all athletic and non-athletic extra-curricular activities: 1st offense = Any student reported for use of alcohol, tobacco, controlled substance (steroids are a controlled substance), or who commits a significant act of violence, or who commits an illegal act shall be suspended from participation in all extra-curricular activities for one-fourth of each current season's activities. In the event the offense occurred at the end of a season, the total penalty or penalties would take effect at the start of the next season. 2nd offense = suspension from participation in all extra-curricular activities for one calendar year after all previous penalties have been served. 3rd offense = an additional one calendar year suspension to be served after all previous penalties have been served. | | | | | |
